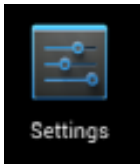
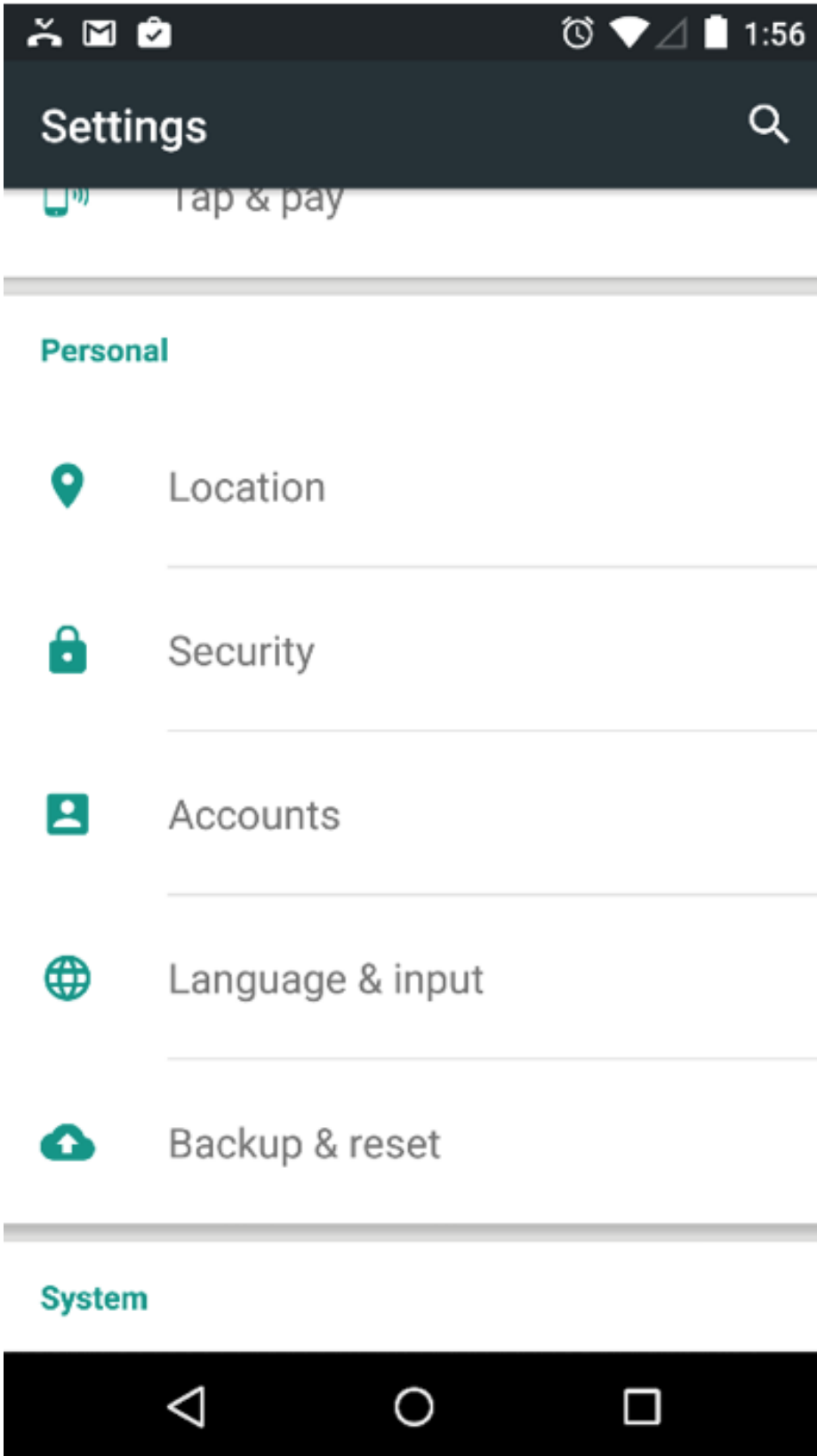


This is a setup guide that will assist you in setting up your Hosted Mailbox on Google Nexus mobile and tablet devices using IMAP.

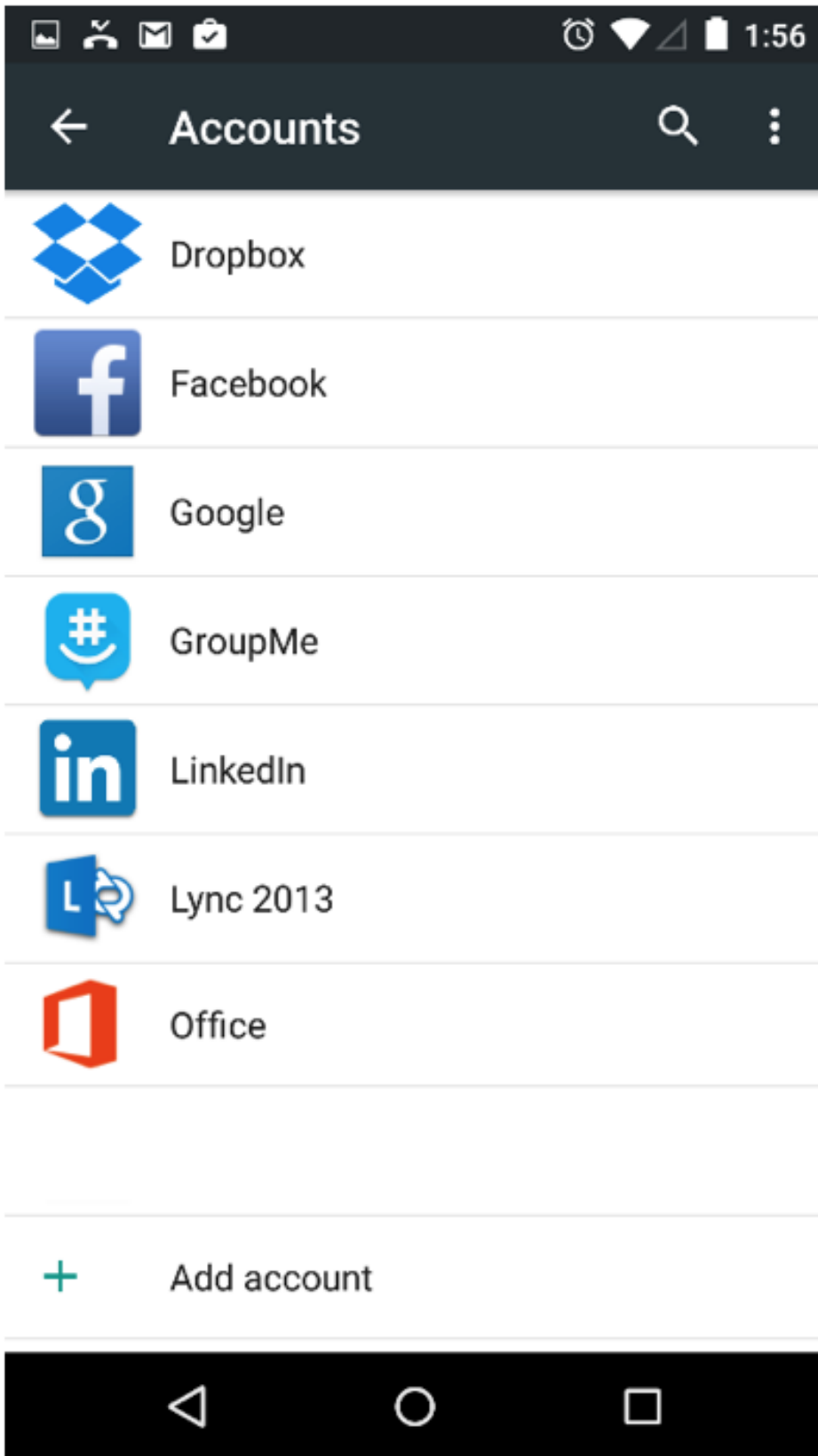
1. Locate the "Settings" icon within your Apps Drawer.



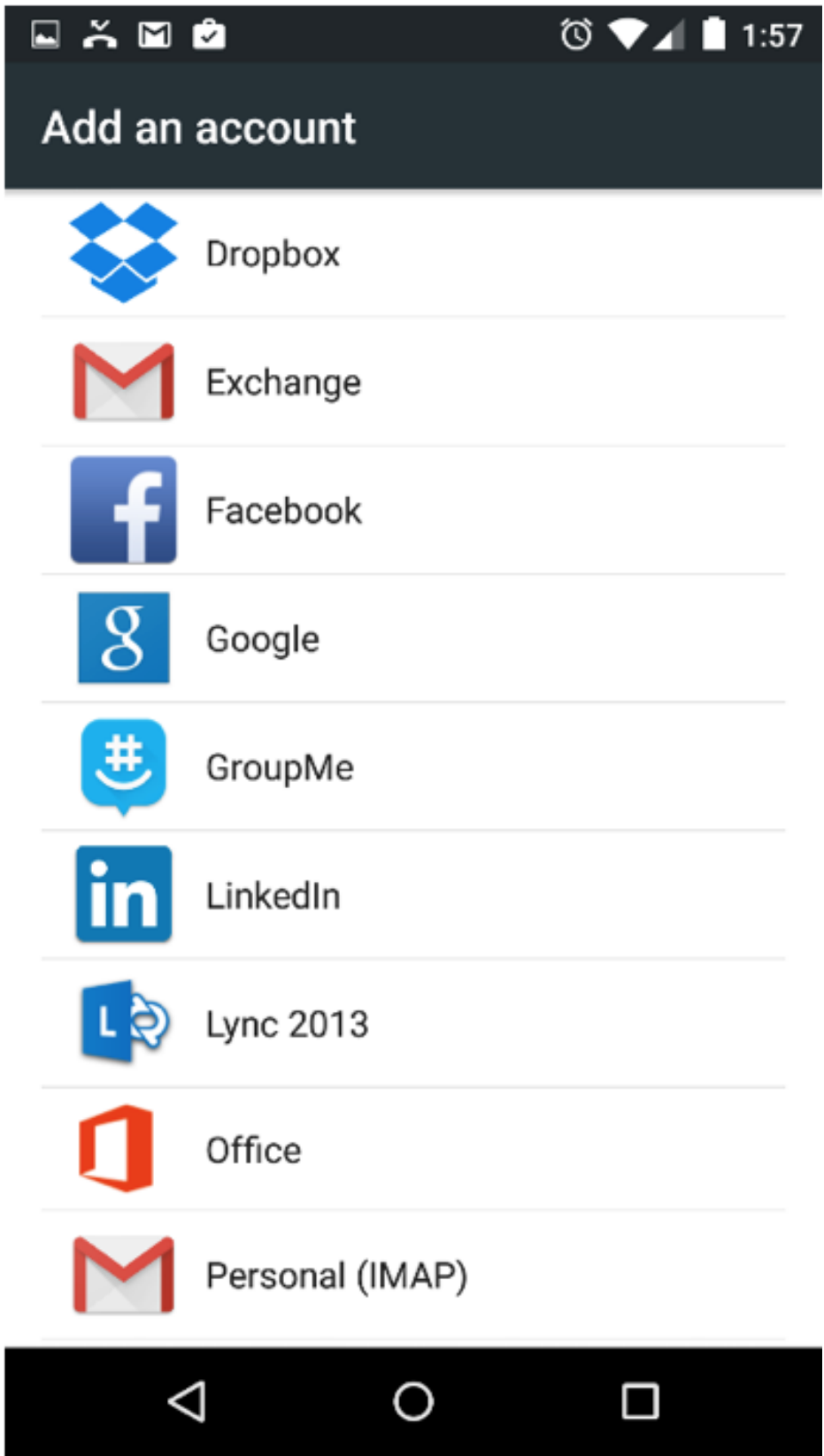
2. Within Settings, scroll down to the "Personal" section and select "Accounts".

 - f. "IMAP path prefix": Leave this field blank

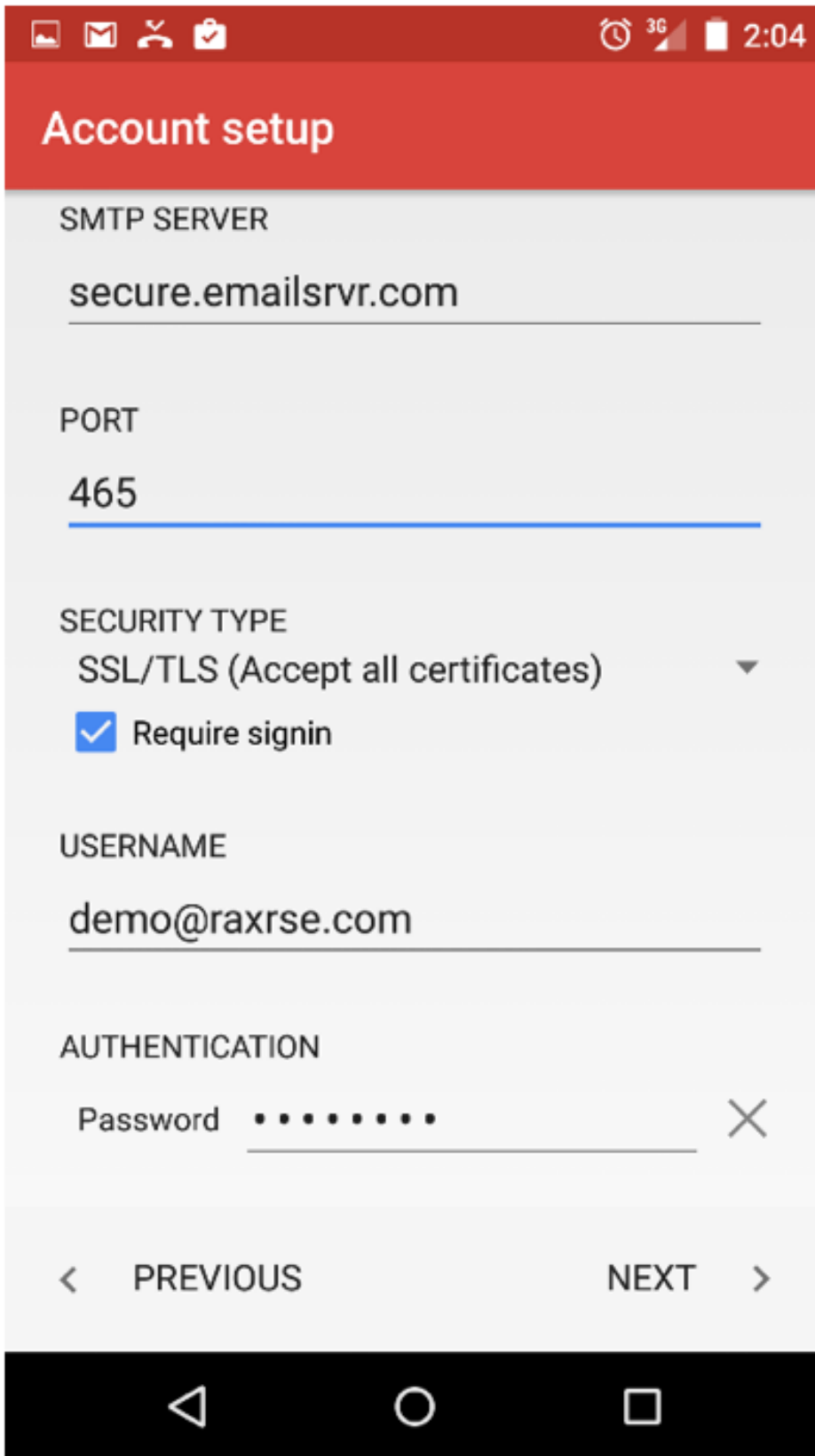

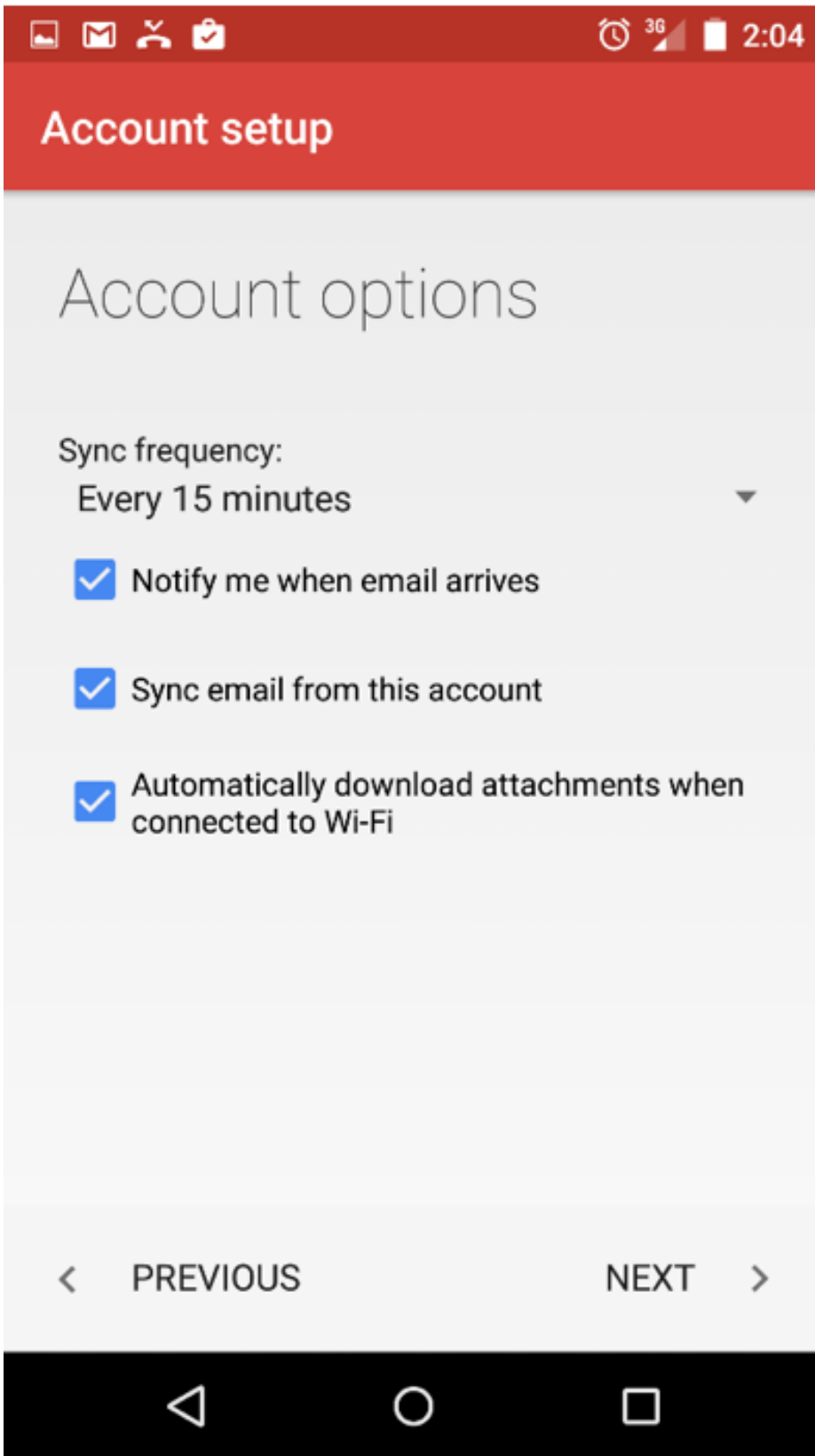
8. Tap "Next".

- b. "Port": 465
- c. "Security Type": SSL/TLS (Accept all certificates)
- d. "Require signin": Checked
- e. "Username": Example@1791.com
- f. "Password": Your email address password



10. Tap "Next".
11. Adjust the displayed mailbox settings, if applicable.



12. Tap "Next".
